

CEMETERY COSTS

• GRAVES •

Unless otherwise noted, the following conditions apply:

- A concrete outer burial container or vault is a cemetery requirement for the burial of casket, but not an urn.
- Only one headstone is permitted per grave, but it can have two names on it.

- With few exceptions, regular cemetery working hours are from 8:30 am to 3:30 pm, Monday through Friday. There is usually a surcharge for labor performed outside regular working hours.

Notes:

- a. Cemetery is regulated by the Division of Cemeteries, NY Department of State.
- b. Requires concrete outer box for interment of cremated remains.
- c. Chapel available for services.
- d. Only baptized Catholic may purchase lot; then may grant burial rights to non-Catholic.
- e. Explicitly allows cremated pet remains; others may permit in some cases.
- f. Two urns allowed in cremation grave.
- g. Single-depth interment of casket is \$650; first interment in double-depth grave is \$850. Green burial interment is \$800 plus \$400 maintenance fee assessed at interment.

CEMETERY COSTS

• MAUSOLEUMS & COLUMBARIUMS •

Generally, cemeteries permit one container of cremated remains to be placed in a single niche; two containers in a double niche. Unless otherwise noted, the

cost of lettering name(s) on the crypt or on the niche is included in the purchase price of the crypt or niche.

• CREMATORY CHARGES •

Note: Charges shown are typical; fee may vary by weight and size of body and casket. According to New York State law, no one but a licensed funeral director can obtain the

cremation permit and supervise the transportation of the remains to the crematory. The funeral director will add the crematory's charge to the price listed for his services.

• DISPOSITION OF CREMATED REMAINS •

In New York State there are no laws that specifically control how the family may dispose of cremated remains. However, as you know, there are anti-littering and public nuisance laws and ordinances. All crematories in the Rochester area "process" the cremated remains to reduce the maximum size of the fragments to about the size of a grain of rice. When returned to the family, the cremated remains are contained in a metal can or plastic box that is perfectly suitable for placing in a

niche or for burying. The purchase of an urn is not required.

A number of churches in the Rochester area have made provisions for the memorialization of cremated remains either in a columbarium or a memorial garden on their premises. Churches with a columbarium will usually permit more than one container of cremated remains in a niche. Cremated remains are either buried or scattered in a memorial garden depending on the custom of the church.
